“ADVANCES IN NON-NEWTONIAN FLUID MECHANICS”

The Kavli Royal Society International Centre at Chicheley Hall



The INNFM has decided to move outside Wales for its 2013 meeting and will be hosting a meeting on “Advances in Non-Newtonian Fluid Mechanics” in the Kavli Royal Society International Centre at Chicheley Hall in the heart of rural Buckinghamshire (<http://royalsociety.org/aboutus/history/Kavli>) (www.chicheleyhall.co.uk). You will see from the websites that Chicheley Hall has 47 rooms on site, so we will probably also need to use nearby hotels. The meeting will commence at 12 noon on Monday March 25th and finish just before lunch on Wednesday March 27th. The theme of the meeting will be “**Advances in Non-Newtonian Fluid Mechanics**”. It will contain an important Mini-Symposium on “**Theoretical Rheology**” to commemorate the work of

Professor Russell Davies, who will be retiring from his current position as Head of the Institute of Mathematics at Cardiff University in December 2013. (This part of the meeting will be overseen by our Cardiff colleague, Professor Tim Phillips, PhillipsTN@cardiff.ac.uk). As in previous meetings, there will be a poster session with a prize for the best poster. We would welcome posters from all delegates, even if they are also presenting papers.

The current President of the British Society of Rheology, Dr William Frith (Unilever), will give his Presidential Address at the meeting and the AGM of the BSR will also take place on the Tuesday afternoon. The Tuesday after-dinner speech will again be given by one of the Keynote lecturers, Professor J.Giacomin (Madison). The main sponsors of the meeting will be TA Instruments, Anton-Paar, and Cardiff University.

Venue: Chicheley Hall is a historically-significant Grade 1 Georgian Country House set within 75 acres of gardens. It is located in Buckinghamshire, just 10 minutes by car from Milton Keynes Central Station. Trains run frequently from London Euston station with a journey time of approximately 30 minutes.

Costs: The total cost of single occupancy at Chicheley Hall will be £450, with accompanying persons being charged £200, provided the payment is received by March 1st 2013. After that date, the Registration Fee for participants will rise to £500.

The registration fee includes full-board accommodation from Monday lunch to Wednesday breakfast. The accompanying-person rate is for someone sharing a room with a conference delegate. Given that the total number of rooms in Chicheley Hall is 47, early registration is recommended!
